PUBLIC MASSES RESUME: Effective Friday, June 11, places of worship in Ontario can open to 15% capacity. Therefore, we have returned to public Masses with 15% capacity following the pandemic protocol that we have had in place in our church for over a year. Pre-registration is not required since our church has always had ample space to safely accommodate our numbers.

IT'S TIME: Now that vaccinations are rolling out quickly, and restrictions are gradually being lifted, it's time to start thinking about your return to the celebration of Mass and the reception of the Holy Eucharist. After months of uncertainty, warranted and unwarranted fears, and nearly unhealthy doses of hopelessness, the Mass is precisely the place we can bring those feelings—anxiety, fear and nervousness—and lay them down at the altar with Christ.


SUNDAY OFFERING: June 13 - \$4,043.50
