CWL FOOD DRIVE: CWL Food Drive: Our CWL food bank collection runs until the end of June, every second weekend of the month. Presently, of the 138 families, or about 300 people using the food bank, approximately 100 are children. The number has increased by 30+ families since March 2021. Since December, our parishioners have donated 270 pounds of food and \$5180.00 in cash donations. "Feed the hungry and help those in trouble. Then your light will shine out of the darkness." Novena for Pentecost: To celebrate this feast commemorating the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Church, prepare with **9** days of prayer beginning this coming Friday. In the New Testament, this biblical event is often quoted from Acts of the Apostles, 1:12 - 2:5. The following traditional prayer is recommended:

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth.

O, God, who by the light of the Holy Spirit, did instruct the hearts of the faithful, grant that by the same Holy Spirit we may be truly wise and ever enjoy His consolations. Through Christ Our Lord, Amen.
