**CHURCH EXTERIOR RESTORATION COLLECTION**: The amount of \$2,418.00 from the month of May was recently sent to the Chancery Office in Pembroke. This monthly appeal uses a special envelope and collection dedicated to the Church Exterior Restoration Debt. With the oversight of the Parish Finance Committee and Mr. John Tammadge as its delegated officer and our Diocesan Finance Administrator, these donations are sent to the Diocese on a monthly basis in order to reduce our debt. Now and in the years to come, these Exterior Restoration Debt Donations will not be permitted to be used for regular operating expenses or minor capital expenditures/repairs. The total amount borrowed from the diocese for the five year Church Exterior Restoration totalled \$2,682,000. As at May 9,2022, the balance of the loan is: \$2,088,694.94. To date, parishioners have contributed \$692,305.00. We are grateful for your ongoing generosity and sacrifice and we are pleased that soon the balance of the loan will drop below the \$2,000,000 mark! Sincere thanks!

**NEWS FROM FATHER STEVE:** it is important for all to enjoy periods of rest and a lightened schedule during the summer, and your priests share in this need. I am grateful to the priests who are coming on the weekend to give me a rest and Deacon Chris who is facilitating their visits for Mass.....you may have noticed that our repaired stained glass window has returned and a new glazed window has been installed as well. A very reputable Ottawa company completed this work. The deductible for each insurance claim is \$2,500. The cost for repairs totalled just under \$5,000.....with the shingles on the church roof in Amprior being repaired, we are awaiting repairs to our lawn and replacement of our cracked sidewalks caused by the roof repair equipment. We have expressed to our insurance company that all must be restored to its original state.....I am formulating a plan for the stained glass windows in Braeside to be better protected from vandalism, as well as those at St. John Chrysostom. Given the number of windows at St. John Chrysostom and the expense involved in protecting them, this will no doubt be a multi year project.....we are investigating the sewer gas smell on the second floor of the rectory in Amprior and the replacement of the second floor air conditioning components has begun in earnest.....we are adding additional lighting around the church and rectory in Amprior. It is important that things be a bit brighter for our security and safety......we thank all for their ongoing financial donations to our parishes and invite all who have not made such a commitment, to do so to assist us with the ongoing care of our buildings and property, and to provide ongoing pastoral service in Amprior and Braeside. God bless you all!
