

EPIPHANY BLESSING OF A HOME: The tradition of blessing the home each year on Epiphany dates from the Middle Ages. As a place where the Lord is revealed in our relationships, the home is blessed in the following manner: a priest or parent uses blessed chalk to mark the inside of the front door with the initials "CMB", an abbreviation for the Latin blessing: *Christus mansionem benedicat*, which means, "May Christ bless this house." Throughout the year, those who come and go through the front door of your house will enjoy the blessing of Christ. These initials also represent the Magi named by tradition as Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar. The initials are preceded by the first two digits of the year and followed by the last two digits, with a small cross between

the letters and the numbers: 20+C+M+B+24.
