**STATIONS OF THE CROSS:** Every Friday night during Lent, starting on February 16<sup>th</sup> the Franciscans will lead the stations of the cross at 7:00 p.m.

FIVE WEEK BIBLICAL WALK-THROUGH CHRIST'S PASSION: Join in a "Pilgrimage that reveals Christ's amazing love for us" at St. Francis Xavier Main Parish Hall in Renfrew. Each one-hour session takes place on Thursday evenings at 7:00 p.m. – February 15, 22 & 29, March 7 & 14. Using Ascension Press' 30-minute videos and discussions we will deepen our faith this Lent and Easter, deepen our understanding of the Passion of Christ, follow the events of the Passion and Death of Jesus, and learn how to apply the Passion of Christ to our own lives.

### THE TRADITIONAL LENTEN DISCIPLINES:



- 1. Prayer: Catholics are encouraged to be more mindful of the presence of God and desire for friendship by praying more during Lent, especially with Sacred Scripture. Lent is also an ideal time to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Making time for weekday Mass, spiritual reading, Eucharistic adoration, the Stations of the Cross, praying of the Rosary as a family, days of reflection, scripture study groups, and Lenten workshops is also encouraged.
- 2. Fasting & Abstinence: Catholics of age 14 and older abstain from meat (beast or fowl) on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Fridays during Lent. In addition, on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, Catholics from age 18 59 fast, limiting themselves to one full meal and two smaller meals each day. Why not consider how food is wasted. What is the quality of your interaction during mealtimes at home? Give up some treat you enjoy. Abstain from alcoholic beverages and expensive cuts of meat. Eat of the food of the poor: a bowl of rice per day and some vegetables.
- **3. Almsgiving:** Moved by the sacrifice of Christ, we give generously to the poor and not just from our surplus. We can simplify our lifestyle, reduce our consumerism and give that discretionary income to those in need. Almsgiving can be combined with fasting, giving to the poor the money saved by eating, drinking or buying less as we rely more upon God's abundant grace. May the experience of physical hunger also remind us of our deep need and desire for Christ the Bread of Life.
