SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION OF MARY:

- On August 15th we celebrate the Assumption of the Virgin Mary. The Feast of the Assumption celebrates both the happy departure of Mary from this life by her natural death, and her assumption into heaven. "Now toward the end of the summer season, at a time when fruits are ripe in the gardens and fields, the Church celebrates the most glorious "harvest festival" in the Communion of Saints. Mary, the supremely blessed one among women, Mary, the most precious fruit which has ripened the fields of God's kingdom, is today taken into the granary of heaven." *Pius Parsch, The Church's Year of Grace*
- The Assumption completes God's work in her since it was not fitting that the flesh that had given life to God himself should ever undergo corruption. The Assumption is God's crowning of His work as Mary ends her earthly life and enters eternity. The Solemnity turns our eyes in that direction, where we will follow when our earthly life is over. Feast days of the Church are not just the commemoration of historical events; they do not look only to the past. They look to the present and to the future and give us an insight into our own relationship with God. The Assumption looks to eternity and gives us hope that we, too, will follow Our Lady when our life is ended.
- In 1950, in the Apostolic Constitution *Munificentissimus Deus*, Pope Pius XII proclaimed the long-held belief in the Assumption of Mary a dogma of the Catholic Church. He also declared: "It is our hope that belief in Mary's bodily Assumption into heaven will make our belief in our own resurrection stronger and render it more effective."
